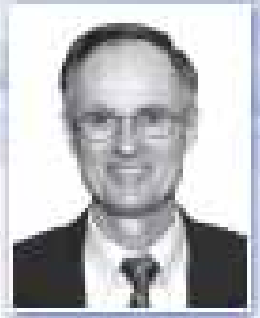

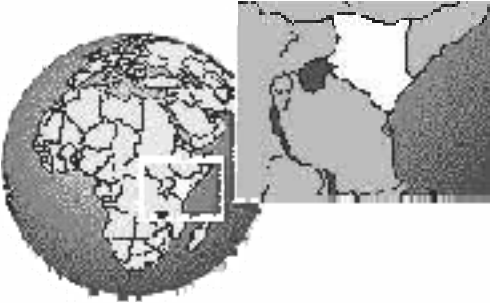

BIBLE DRILL BASH:

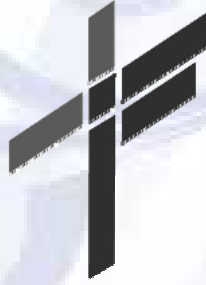

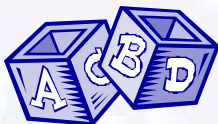
ONE GREAT DAY OF SERVING:
